A Tribute

S I made my preparations to take the journey which should bring me to this Reunion of the David H. Dafler family, my mental eyes followed this sturdy branch of Daflers back to the trunk of the Tree, and I felt that I wanted to pay tribute to the firm, determined spirit that set up this family and made its successes and attainments possible.

Coming out from Germany many years ago as a little girl, Catherine Rosanna Rumier later met and married John Wolfgang Dafler and, leaving behind a whole grove of Dafler trees in the Old World, set up a household of their own and began to erect a Family Tree in a new country.

From this new Tree sprang eleven big branches which the Mother named John, Dave, Christ, Rose, Lew, Lizzie, Maggie, Melchior, Wesley, Charlie, Upton.

It was the economy, self-sacrifice, persistence, thrift and strength of this Mother, instilled into the minds of her offspring which has made the present Dafler families a financial and moral power in the communities where they reside.

These qualities in the children began to show themselves in early life when, as one by one the boys began to go out from under the Family Rooftree, they made good in the more modes! way of that time and brought back their earnings and poured them into the lap of the Mother who used what was brought for the good of all.

Then the girls began to go out one by one, and they, following the example set by their brothers, brought their small offerings

to be applied to uses in the home.

After that the boys began one by one to establish homes of their own; and then the girls did the same.

The trunk of the Family Tree became stronger and more powerful as years went by; and also the ten surviving big branches which had come from this mighty stem, grew vigorously. Then the branches put forth branchlets and soon, gathering under the Parental Tree, came little Annie and Henry and Hettie and Bina and Retta and Dollie and Maude and a troop of other little figures followed.

But even that period of the growth of the Tree is now ancient history, for the Henrys and Hetties and Maudes have taken root in the soil as heads of households and a new generation of beautiful, robust, keen-minded and active young twigs have shot out into life, to render more powerful the great principles so dominant in the characters of the old Mother and Father now

long passed on to their reward.

So today as the great and growing Dafler family sits under the shade of the David H. Dafler branch and enjoys its hospitality and feels the young life pulsing through its veins, let us offer special tribute to the great Mother from whom we all sprang. and to David Dafler who, as her second son, loyally helped in her early endeavors and later left a substantial heritage to his splendid boys and girls.

Greetings

To my many Aunts, Uncles and Cousins, assembled today under the spreading boughs of the great trees of this beautiful grove.

The family of Dafler - may it live long, succeed splendidly and prosper bountifully!

For the past two years the thought of the great family that has sprung from the union of Catherine Rosanna Rumler and John Wolfgang Dafler has grown in impressiveness. At present it will not be difficult to assemble and place on record the complete register of those who by birth or by marriage have helped to enlarge the great circle. The idea of gathering the data for a Family Tree has at last fully taken form in the minds of a few of the older members and has in part materialised. It will be comparatively easy to collect this data now but exceedingly difficult a few years hence.

'The story of the lives of our hardy ancestors reads back in the case of our Grandfather Dafier to the end of the 18th century and in the case of our Grandmother Dafier to the beginning of the 19th century.

The story of their married life and of the birth of their children brings down to the period before and during the Civil War.

Such a long extent of time - - about 128 years - - has witnessed a tremendous growth from the one stalk from which the Dafler family sprang. As years go by that growth will proceed much more rapidly until the origin and early history will be lost in the multiplied ramifications, unless we take steps while it is easily possible to trace back our family ties and to preserve the story of our common ancestry. To this end we have made a beginning and with the help of each family head we can add to our data until a complete list of names of those connected by hirth or by marriage with the family of Dafler shall have been properly enrolled with dates of births, deaths, marriages, addresses, etc.

We have now five generations to record. In the course of a comparatively few years another generation will be coming upon the scene. To it and to succeeding generations our family record should become increasingly valuable.

It is usually a matter of great pride to be able to trace one's history back through a long line of great ancestors. It should, in years to come, be a source of great interest, too, to note how far and in what directions the outstanding characteristics of the two great Founders of the family have flowed, to what extent marriage has intensified those qualities or modified or diminished them. This can be studied if each family head will make it his business to revive and keep alight all the family traditions he can recall and transmit them as traditions, to his children and grandchildren.

It will be seen also, how intimately the stories of our family life fit into the history and evolutionary growth of our great country, and this to the Dafler children of the future, will be a very interesting study.

I am earnestly hoping that the family members here assembled

today will each write into the book of our history the names and dates available to the compiler of this history in no other way. And I am suggesting that as this record will be put into more or less complete form very soon, that as the David Henry Dafler family assembles for its annual election of officers that a new office be created - that of "Custodian of the John and Catherine Dafler Records" and that a custodian for the coming year be elected, preferably for this first year and as an honor to the great family, from among the sons and daughters of the Founders - the members of the Second generation.

This Custodian should be impressed with the value of the records he is to hold and the sacred duty he owes to the great family.

To this Custodian each family head should give notice of any birth, death or marriage, o. any change of address occuring in his family, with full data regarding same, so that the Custodian may enter it in the records in proper manner. At the end of each year the Custodian should produce his records and read the happenings of the year and be ready to turn over the history brought down fully to date, to the newly elected Custodian.

No greater honor could be paid to the rugged and energetic Founders of this prolific and dependable family than a scrupillously perfect record of its membership. And to its members in future generations no volume could hold greater interest or excite greater pride.

Hoping that these ideas meet with the approval of my relatives here assembled and that they may be adopted for the interest of the many Daflers yet to come as well as for the pleasure of those of us now playing our little parts on Life's great stage, I submit the Family Tree to you as far as I have been able to construct it.

I acknowledge very great assistance rendered by our aunts Mrs. Elizabeth Hughes of Dayton, Ohio, and Mrs. Margaret Toliver of Richmond, Indiana and my cousin Mrs. Hettle Law Wysong of West Alexandria, Ohio who have contributed valuable information.

Again my greetings to all assembled.

Presentation of the Tree

In honor of the memory of my Mother and Father, the worthy heads of this great family, and as a tribute to their many fine qualities which have been transmitted to generation after generation, I present to the Dafler Family this record of our lineage, in behalf of my daughter, Lauretta Belle Kepler, who compiled it.

Ristory of the Origin of the Dafler Family

To begin with we must go back to June 20, 1798, or 135 years, 1 month and 10 days ago today to Beyreuth, Germany, where, on that date June 20, 1798, there was born a baby boy to whom was given the name Johan Wolfgang Doerfler.

This little boy was reared at Tensenlohe, on his father's farm. At the age of about 22 years he was drafted for Military Service, but was promptly released as is evidenced by the following certificate.

"Presenter of this, Wolfgang Doerfler, born in 1798, in Tensenlohe, Kings, Circuit Court, Beyreuth, in Upper Main Circuit, Evangelical Religion, State of singleness, a Farmer, has after being called for conscription, done this in the regular way, being found totally unsuited to enter into any military service, he was released from such service and received the present Release Certificate so as to make the necessary use of the orders of the Conscription Laws and to identify himself everywhere.

Beyreuth, the 11th April, 1820."

Including the nineteen years following the above date I am unable to state definitely anything about his whereabouts or doings. It has always been my understanding that he lived with and worked for his father, which, according to the stories he used to relate, was not the most pleasant to say the least. During these latter years it seems that he, his brother and sister-in-law decided to go to America and having so decided they took out their church letters as the following indicates.

"That the two brothers and sister-in-law, including two children from Tenzeniohe, Kings Circuit Court, Beyreuth, as follows:

1st Johan Wolfgang Doerfler; 3rd John Kunrad Doerfler; 3rd Anna Catherine Doerfler, and their two children: 1st Johan Doerfler; Anna Barbara Doerfler, which want to emigrate to North America, are known to be faithful and industrious workers and in general led a very good and honorable life, and were released from our local congregation without comment. All this is attested by the undersigned according to the truth,

Dated Heinersreuth, the 4th September, 1839.

(SEAL) The Congregation Administration, Adam Doerfler, Councilman."

Having completed preliminary arrangments for leaving the Fatherland, this Johan Wolfgang Doerfler was obliged to procure Transport Papers in order that he might be honorably released and privileged to leave the country. This he did on the 5th day of September, 1839. His passport is translated as follows:

"Kingdom of Bavaria, Ober Franken. Passport to the Foreign Land: The Council of police department of the Kingly Circuit Court of Beyreuth requests, under promise of doing the same service, all departments of other states, to let the single farmer Wolfgang Doerfler, born from Tenzenlohe, living at Tenzenlohe, who, after receiving Emigrating Permit, wants to travel to North America, via Coburg, Bremen, take his departure unhindered and safe and also give him any assistance and protection if needed. The present pass is valid for the trip to the States.

Beyreuth, The 5th September, 1839.

Register Pass No. 61

Description of traveler: Age, 41 years; Height, 5 feet 5 inches, 3 lines; Hair, reddish; Forehead, high; Hyebrows, blond; Hyes, Blue; Nose, bend; Mouth, broad; Beard, reddish; Chin, oval; Face, longish; Color, pale; Signature of Traveler, Johan Wolfgang Doerfler."

That the request of the Council of Police of Beyreuth for the safe conduct of the traveler was honored by the Departments of the other states through which he passed on his way to take ship for America is amply verified by the following visas.

"No. 1011. Seen by the Presidium of the Kings Administration of Ober Franken, Beyreuth, the 5th September, 1839. (SHAL)

No. 1048. Valid over Hanover to Bremen; owner has the necessary cap-age and commutation money. Dudustadt, the 12th of September, 1839.

No. 830. Seen and valid for traveling to Baltimore. Bremen, the 20th September, 1839.

(SIGNED) . The Police Department."

Embarking on a sailing vessel at Bremen, Johan Wolfgang Doerfier left his native land forever, presumably on September 20, 1839. The reason I say he left on a sailing vessel is because I remember distinctly hearing him tell at different times (and in this story I was always greatly interested) that they were on a sailing vessel 74 days and on a steamer's days, having spent 77 days on the Atlantic Ocean between Bremen and Baltimore. One of the main reasons for it taking so long to cross the ocean in those days was that sailing craft naturally made slow time. The wind was often a hindrance, too; on a number occasions blowing them back further than they had come the day before. Using the above date and figures I compute that he must have landed in Baltimore on or about December 7, 1839, and started a new and free life in, or in the vicinity of Baltimore, Maryland.

Now let us go back again to Germany - this time 107 years, 10 months and 24 days from this date on which I write. There on September 6, 1825, in Wittenberg (a town of Prussian Baxony and interesting as the cradle of the Reformation) Rosanna Catherine Rumeier first saw the light of day. No reliable information

or definite data as to her early life is obtainable; but older members of our family recall from stories she told in later life that she with her parents (whose names we do not know), her brother, Daniel Reisley, and her sisters Maria and Rose Reisley (children by a former marriage) left Germany some time during the latter part of her sixth year, they having spent her sixth birthday aboard ship, presumably a sailing vessel. We may reasonably assume that they landed as late as November, 1831, and the port was Baltimore as she so often told us. Thus she had been in America approximately 8 years before the landing of Johan Wolfgang Doerfler, who, according to the best information available, had written his name "Dafler" from the time of his arrival on these shores, and so it has been spelled ever since.

It is a matter of sincere regret that the story of the first years of those two persons in America is unknown - these two to whom we as a family are so closely attached and so deeply indebted. For in course of time they met and married. We have no record of the time or place but judge from subsequent known events that the year was 1841 and that Carroll County, Maryland, was the (all too vague) place, the bride being then 16 years of age and the groom 27 years her senior. To this union were born, in the course of time, three daughters and eight sons (I being one of the latter).

It was after the birth of the second child that our father became a citizen of the United States, the complete Court proceedings being set forth in the paper of which the following is a copy:

"State of Maryland, Carroll County,

To Wit:

At a County Court of the Third Judicial District of the State of Maryland, begun and held at the Court-House in the town of Westminster in and for the County aforesaid, on the first Monday of September in the year of our Lord, One Thousand, Eight Hundred and Forty-Five,

Present

The Honorable Thomas B. Dorcey, Thomas Wilkinson and Nicholas Bieneer, Esq., I. Henry Hoppe, Jacob Shoueer,

Chief Judge,

Associate Judges, Sheriff, Clerk.

Among other were the following proceedings, to wit:

BE IT REMEMBERED, that on the second day of September in the year aforesaid John Doerfier, a Native of Bayron, and at present residing in the County of Carroll, appeared in the open court here and applied to be admitted to become a citisen of the United States. And it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court here that the said John Doefler has declared on eath, taken in the County Court aforesaid, on the Third day of April, in the year One Thousand, Eight Hundred and Forty-Three, two

years at least before his admission, that it was Bona-fide his Intention to become a citizen of the United States. And it also appearing to the satisfaction of the Court here, upon the testimony of Michael Sullivan and Henry Timmerman, citizens of the United States, that the said John Doerster hath continued to reside within the limits and under the jurisdiction of the United States, five years at least, and one year at least immediately preceding this application, within the state of Maryland; that during the said term of five years he hath resided in Carroll County, and hath conducted himself as a man of good moral character, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the same; and the said John Doerfler, having declared on oath, taken in open court here, that he will support the Constitution of the United States and that he doth absolutely and entirely renounce and adjure all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign prince, potentate, state and sovereignty, and particularly all allegiance and fidelity to the Duke of Bayron; the Court there upon admits the said John Doerfler to become a citizen of the United States.

In testimony that the foregoing is a true copy, taken from the records of the proceedings of the Court aforesaid, I subscribe my name and affix the seal of the said Court to this Certificate of Naturalization, this Second Day of September, in the year of our Lord One Thousand, Eight Hundred and Forty-five.

(SEAL) Jacob Shouser, Clerk of Carroll County Court."

I feel that it would not be out of place to say that Father and Mother started their married life (like most Daflers have done since) with nothing but stout hearts and good reputations, and these valuable assets have been handed down to every individual having Dafler and Rumeler blood in their veins. This is a matter of pride especially to their immediate descendents who still have memory of the times in which the heads of the House of Dafler lived. They worked and saved, especially did Mother, whose energy and resourcefulness seemed unending, under the most difficult conditions imaginable, and though they were unable to accumulate a fortune, (unlike the acorn that was dropped down among the underbrush, sprouted, started to grow and worked and wiggled its way up through troublesome growths and finally became a forest king) their large family was always adequately housed, fed and clothed and no debts were left unpaid. This is a record which I doubt any of us could have equalled, much less bettered in the times and under the conditions in which they lived.

They gave to their children what is better than money first, their example of industry and uprightness, and second, the inherited tendency to work and plan and grow. The family has grown and I do not hesitate to say has become worthy and influential in spite of handicaps. As proof of growth we have compiled a complete and accurate Genealogical Tree which is now in the possession of Harry W. Dafler as its Special Custodian, As proof of worthiness and influence the communities in which we live will speak for us. I say these things, not haughtly, but with pride in our parents who did not strive in vain and to whom our vast and fine family is a memorial.

I have in mited a little poem which will give point to what I have been trying to bring out. It applies precisely to the big story of our family life and is called:—

Good Timber

The tree that never had to fight For sun and sky and air and light, That stood out in the open plain And always got its share of rain, Never became a forest king But lived and died a scrubby thing.

The man who never had to toil, Who never had to win his share Of sun and sky and light and air, Never became a manly man, But lived and died as he began.

Good timber does not grow in ease; The stronger wind, the tougher trees; The farther *ky, the greater length; The more the storm, the more the strength; By sun and cold, by rain and snows In tree or man good timber grows.

Where thickest stands the forest growth We find the patriarchs of oak; And they hold converse with the stars; Their broken branches show the scars Of many winds and much of strife. Such is the common law of life.
